What Instrument Do You Want to Play?

Dear Pinecrest Fourth Grade Parents and Guardians,

Central Kitsap School District believes music to be an important part of all students' education. We offer general music classes to all our elementary students. Beginning in the fifth grade, band and orchestra are offered to those students who want to begin to learn to play an instrument, so they can be part of the band or orchestra in middle and high school. Beginning Band and Orchestra is designed to be the start of a multiyear curriculum. Band and orchestra require extra time and effort from both the student and parent, such as consistent home practicing, attending two evening performances, obtaining a quality instrument, and bringing an instrument back and forth from home to school every day, etc. Students love seeing how their hard work and dedication to an instrument can pay off to create cool music and increasingly provide more challenges to master!

Today, students were introduced to several band and orchestra instruments during school in hopes they will select an instrument they would like to play. These instruments are carefully selected by the director for each student to match them with the instrument that they would be most successful with in a large mixed instrument class. The choice is an important one and should be give careful thought and consideration. Students will make the most progress picking an instrument and sticking with it as they progress through the program into middle and high school. Later, students may audition for advanced instruments as they develop their musical abilities, knowledge and practice habits. Band and Orchestra Responsibilities

Learning to play an instrument is exciting and fun! However, joining the band or orchestra does include extra responsibilities for both families and students. Knowing these responsibilities will help you decide if joining the band or orchestra is the right choice for your family.

Family Responsibilities:

- Home practice: Provide a place and time to practice, and make sure your student practices at home.
- Evening performances: Provide transportation for your student to attend two evening performances one in the Fall and one in the Spring.
- Provide and instrument and all required materials. (The school has resources to help families with demonstrated financial need)
- Make sure your student has the ability and transportation necessary to bring their instrument to and from school each day for home practice, regardless of the size of the instrument.


Student Responsibilities:
